

# How to Sign Up for a **COVID-19 Vaccine** in Texas



## Finding a Vaccine Provider:

- For vaccine finder tools go to [dshs.texas.gov/covidvaccine](https://dshs.texas.gov/covidvaccine).
- Call (833) 832-7067, 7am - 7pm 7 days a week, for help finding a vaccine provider if you:
  - Don't have internet
  - Want help by phone
  - Speak Spanish or other languages



## Signing Up for a Vaccine:

- Check the provider's website for sign-up information and vaccine availability.
- Call the provider if the website doesn't answer your questions or if you don't have internet.
- COVID-19 vaccines are free. You should not be charged for getting a vaccine.



## Who Can Get a Vaccine:

- All people 16 and older can get a COVID-19 vaccine in Texas.
- Only the Pfizer vaccine is authorized for people who are 16 and 17 years old.

## Remember:

### DON'T JUST SHOW UP



Do not show up at a provider without first signing up or checking the provider's instructions for vaccination.

### BE PATIENT - SUPPLY IS LIMITED



Vaccine supply is limited. Not every provider has vaccine each week. Hubs may have waiting lists.

### YOUR SECOND DOSE



Please go back to the same provider for your second dose.
